SUSD/ Copper Ridge "Away for the Day" Student/ Parent Cell Phone Policy Agreement

Trailblazer Community,

I want to start off by thanking all of you in advance for your support this year in helping to create an encouraging, focused, and productive learning environment that spans from "Gate to Gate". One way we can partner in creating this is limiting students cell phone usage. There are always a few questions as to how we proceed with our cell phone policy here at Copper Ridge. This year ALL schools have unified by adopting a "Gate to Gate" policy. Students will be required to place their phones in their back packs as they walk through our gate/out of the cafeteria and will be able to take them out when they exit campus. Please read the following, sign, and have your student return to their 1st period teacher no later than Friday, 08/11.

Students will not be permitted to be on their cellphones during class, passing periods and lunchtime. Cell phones will be kept in backpacks upon entry of campus (through the cafeteria/gate) and until exit of campus (Gate to Gate). Air pods, ear buds and headphones are not allowed as well. Please do not text or call your students during the school day, if you need to get ahold of them, call the front office and we will make contact.

In terms of discipline for students using their phones during the school day, the following matrix will be followed.

- First Offense: Phone will be confiscated and held in the front office until the end of day. (Parent phone call)
- Second Offense: Phone will be confiscated and held in the front office until parent can pick it up. (Parent phone call)
- Third Offense: Phone will be confiscated & held in the front office until parent can pick it up, detention assigned & loss of phone at school. (Parent phone call)

Your student has been informed of the above consequences associated with not adhering to our cell phone policy. Please reiterate with them the importance and how it helps create a positive learning environment.
